SCIENTIFIC NAME: LEONTOPITHECUS CHRYSOPYGUS

IUCN RED LIST STATUS: ENDANGERED

ESTIMATED NUMBER OF MATURE INDIVIDUALS: 1,600 (10X LESS THAN THE AMOUNT OF BORED APES THAT "EXIST" ONLINE)

POPULATION TREND: DECREASING

HABITAT: ATLANTIC FOREST, STATE OF SÃO PAULO, BRAZIL

HABITAT CONDITIONS: SEVERELY FRAGMENTED AND RAPIDLY SHRINKING





THREATS: ANNUAL AND PERENNIAL NON-TIMBER CROPS, WOOD AND PULP PLANTATIONS, LIVESTOCK FARMING AND RANCHING, OIL AND LOGGING AND WOOD HARVESTING, PROBLEMATIC SPECIES/DISEASE OF UNKNOWN ORIGIN, HABITAT SHIFTING AND ALTERATION

CONSERVATION ACTIONS: IN-PLACE LAND/WATER PROTECTION OCCURS OVER THE SPECIES' ENTIRE RANGE. IN-PLACE SPECIES MANAGEMENT EXISTS WITH EX-SITU CONSERVATION. IN-PLACE EDUCATION INCLUDES RECENT EDUCATION AND AWARENESS PROGRAMMES, INTERNATIONAL LEGISLATION, AND INTERNATIONAL MANAGEMENT / TRADE CONTROLS
